Dear Archery Instructor Program Participant:

I am pleased that you will be joining me for the Archery Instructor training at Wyonegonic Camps. **The course will be Thursday June 11th 9:00AM – Friday June 12th 12:00PM**

Archery is an easy sport to teach and can be fun for the campers. However, it is very important that you leave the Instructor's Program with a "key word" and that word is "Safety". The most important responsibility that you will have as an Archery Instructor is to be sure the campers are safe at all times. In order to do that, you will develop a "Plan of Action" for your summer camp program that will include a daily, weekly and monthly schedule for your classes.

Experience with archery is not required. At camp, you will be the Instructor, not the archer.

The bow and arrow is a weapon. If you pass the course, you will be responsible for monitoring children and helping them to understand safety At All Times. You will also be responsible to teach them how to shoot properly. Your behavior during class time will indicate to me, whether or not you can handle this important responsibility.

You will receive a textbook when you arrive. We will highlight the areas that you should study when you have open time. This is your textbook to take back to your camp and to use as a reference.

Archery is a sport and a discipline. During your time with me, you need to demonstrate both skill acquisition and self-discipline. We will be covering a variety of topics and you will have hands-on experience. An ability to follow directions, to listen and to show an understanding of the material is expected. You will need to pass a written exam and a demonstration of your teaching skills.
